The Blood Flood - Biodivine, Part 8

### SUMMARY

Jesus' blood represents not sacrificial payment, but DNA and lineage. Just as God used Noah's flood to preserve human seed for the Messiah's coming, the “blood of Jesus” — our divine DNA and lineage — preserves sons for creation's redemption. The “flesh and blood” of biblical terms refers to human lineage and inheritance from Adam, which cannot recognize Christ or inherit God's kingdom. Through the new covenant in Jesus' blood, we have received a divine transfusion and new lineage, being “born again” with new DNA.

### SEEDS FOR DISCUSSION

- Conscience is “shared knowledge” — we must evaluate who we're partnering with for our understanding of ourselves and God.
- If we don't recognize that conscience is the key to freedom, then we'll try to change behaviors. Changing behaviors is the fruit of a defiled conscience.
- Focusing on the death of Jesus destroys one's conscience. We should focus on resurrection. Jesus Himself said we should look at His death the same way that you look at a child's birth: temporary pain then joy.
- The death of Jesus was the re-heading of humanity.
- “The fall” wasn't about Eve questioning God's word, but about partnering with wrong knowledge that defiled the human conscience.
- God acquiesces to our understanding of Him then blows that up from the inside out. The Old Testament is a constant record of Him doing that.
- The flood in Genesis was an antitype of something that God would do through baptism.
- The “blood flood” destroyed everything we were never meant to be, just as Noah's flood preserved human seed for the Messiah's coming.
