SUMMARY

Sean and Kylie Henderson, ordained pastors from Australia, are touring America and stop in New Philadelphia, Ohio. They share their unique journey of faith and ministry. SEEDS FOR DISCUSSION

- The joy of the Lord is available to you if you just recognize that it's available to you. When you're a Son, all things are available to you. You don't have to go and get them.
- There is no proximity in the kingdom, in the Spirit.
- Pollen doesn't just scatter. It intentionally lands where it is received — in the same way spiritual truths take up root in receptive hearts. Cross-pollination is a divine exchange.
- God speaks to each person uniquely, and we don't need to conform to traditional patterns.
- True joy comes from embracing who God created us to be.
- Divine encounters can happen in unexpected places and ways.
- Unity in the body of Christ doesn't mean uniformity — each person brings their unique expression.
- Living in awareness of God transforms how we see and experience life.
