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The Cosmic Reset Button (Part 2 in Mystical Cruciformity)

### SUMMARY

In Part 2 of our series Mystical Cruciformity, we explore the cosmic reset that occurred through Christ's death on the cross. Jesus didn't just die for humanity; He gathered all things (both in heaven and earth) into Himself and performed a complete reset of creation. Through this act, Jesus killed the old lineage of Adam (humanity) and established a new lineage of Christs, effectively re-heading all of creation.

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## DISCUSSION GUIDE - March 16, 2025, cont.

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### SEEDS FOR DISCUSSION

- We're not trying to overcome sin; we've already been freed from sin through Christ's death and resurrection.
- "Sin" as dysfunction, perceived separation
- Jesus performed a cosmic reset through His death and resurrection, gathering all things in heaven and earth to Himself.
- We are no longer part of Adam's lineage but have been transferred into Christ's lineage.
- The cross was about ending one race (humanity in Adam) and beginning a new race (Christ).
- Jesus saved us from being human.
- Our identity is not based on our behavior but on our inclusion in Christ's death and resurrection.
